



## LOCAL RULES

### FIXED IRRIGATION HEADS (Rule 16)

All fixed irrigation heads are immovable obstructions and relief without penalty is available under Rule 16.1b. In addition, if a ball lies in the general area and an immovable obstruction on or within two club-lengths of the putting green and within two club-lengths of the ball intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may take relief as follows: The ball must be lifted and dropped at the nearest point of complete relief to where the ball lay that a) is not nearer to the hole, b) avoids intervention and c) is not in a penalty area or on a putting green.

### IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (RULE 16)

Relief for Ball, Swing and Stance Only, Not Line of Sight.

- A. Stones, drains and cart traffic posts adjacent to cart paths are deemed part of the obstruction.
- B. All buildings and shelters in the “general area”.
- C. The Pool & Pool House (#6 & #9), Clubhouse (#9 & #18), Maintenance Compound (#11 & #18) and all parking lots surrounding these areas. Mulch and ornamental areas next to these structures are part of the obstruction.
- D. Staked trees – relief without penalty from stakes/wires only.
- E. Maintained flower bed behind #9 green, surrounding the Golf Shop and patio. Players may utilize the designated Drop Zone behind the green.

### TEMPORARY IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (Local Rule F-23)

Greenside Fans will be played as Temporary Immovable Obstructions. Players will receive “line of play” relief from fans.

### INTEGRAL OBJECT

An integral object is an artificial object defined by the Committee as part of the challenge of playing the course. The following are deemed an integral objects and relief without penalty is not available:

- A. Stacked stone walls
- B. Rock outcroppings
- C. Lightning Cables in Trees

### OUT OF BOUNDS (RULE 18.2)

Defined by the inside points, at ground level, of fence posts, white stakes, white lines, and any combination thereof.

#15 & #16 – The rock walls/white stakes on the left side of the creek define out of bounds.
